Terms and Conditions

Membership definitions

Bronze (Student and Persons on benefits & other Individuals):

- Price £20 (upon presentation of a valid proof of student status or benefits, where applicable)
- Free access and materials
- Individual – 1 membership card only

Silver (Not For Profit Groups, Non-fee paying Nurseries, Pre and Special Schools):

- Price £50
- Free access and materials
- 2 to 5 membership cards

Gold (Primary and Secondary Schools)

- Price £100
- Free access and materials
- 6 to 10 membership cards

Platinum (Profit Making Organisations, Fee-paying Nurseries and Schools)

- Price £140
- Free access and materials
- 11 to 15 membership cards

Membership or a membership card is not transferable to another group. For any lost cards a £2 replacement fee will apply. Membership card(s) must be signed by the recipient(s) stated on the card(s) upon receipt.

Visitors

You must bring a valid membership card every time that you visit. Before collecting any material, you must show this card to the person on duty and sign in.

Quantities

People are often unsure about the quantity of materials that they can take. As a general rule take what you need rather than everything that you can carry. It is better for us if you come regularly and take less. If anything is specifically limited, there will be a sign. Please don't hesitate to ask first as we may have lots in stock.

Please Don't!!

It is very important that you do not sell any goods taken from the Scrapstore. This applies especially to new items we have received from companies free of charge as it may ruin our chances of further supplies. This does not preclude the selling of items for fundraising which have been made from materials taken from Scrapstore.

Beware!!

If you are unsure about any of the items, i.e. liquid plastic containers and what they should or shouldn't be used for, please ask a member of staff for advice.

Tidiness

Please help keep the Scrapstore tidy. It gives us more time to collect and stack / store

Collectors

Please limit the number of people you bring on a visit – two is ideal!

Children

Children are allowed in the Scrapstore but they must be supervised by a responsible adult.

Discipline

Any member or group found to breaking any of the terms and conditions will have their membership revoked with immediate effect without reimbursement of any membership fees

Data Protection Act

Swindon Children's Scrapstore adheres to the Data Protection Act and will not disclose your details to any third party companies.

Opening hours

Opening hours are:

- Tuesday to Friday – 10am to 4pm
- Every 1st and 3rd Saturday of the month – 10am to 2pm

Late opening can be arranged in advance if you need us to stay open after 4pm. We are unlikely to do this more than one evening a week. This will be addressed on a first come first served basis.
